VILLAGE OF DANVILLE COUNCIL Met in regular session on Monday, March 16th, 2026, in the Council Chambers. Mayor Mazzari called the meeting to order at 6:08 PM. A motion to approve the minutes as presented on the March 2nd, 2026 meeting, was made by Durbin and seconded by Strouse. Roll call, all yes.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Mazzari administered the Police Officer's Oath of Office to Scott McKnight who will be an auxiliary police officer for the Village.

Frank Harmon discussed the Village remaining with the Ohio Insurance Services Agency for the employee health insurance program. Harmon advised he had received a call from the Village Administrator informing him the Village will be switching away from him and the Ohio Insurance Services Agency. Harmon said there was a letter of brokerage change sent to Anthem confirming the change. Council informed Harmon that they are who makes the decision on whether to change or not. Harmon stated that if the Village stays with him, the new quote for employee health insurance coverage will be 20% below State average going into 2027. The employees will pay 5%. Delta Dental \$239.00, Vision Service Plan \$47.75, Life Insurance \$50,000 - \$6.98 per member, Short Term Disability - \$88.00 total for month. Harmon asked if the council stays with the Ohio Insurance Agency (Anthem), he has a prepared letter of intent confirming the Village's decision and it needs to be signed by the mayor. Council agreed to remain for the year 2026 and the letter was signed by Mayor Mazzari and presented to Harmon.
