

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

DANVILLE VILLAGE COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION

Held: May 4th, 2026

VILLAGE OF DANVILLE COUNCIL Met in regular session on Monday, May 4th, 2026, in the Council Chambers. Mayor Mazzari called the meeting to order at 6:07 PM. Roll call was taken as follows, Lee Meyers, absent. Deb Ridgeway, present. Patrick Crow, present. Darin Durbin, present. Amanda Strouse, present. Jeff Furay, present.
NOTE: Council member Lee Meyers entered the meeting late (time not documented)

OTHER VILLAGE PERSONNEL PRESENT: Village Safety Director-Police Chief Vance

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Mayor Mazzari led the Pledge of Allegiance.

GUESTS: None

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Nothing to report

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motion to go into executive session at 6:09 PM to discuss wages/benefits was made by (name not documented) and seconded by (name not documented). Came out of executive session at 6:30 PM.

OTHER BUSINESS: Motion was made by Strouse to keep wages/benefits as listed in the current Ordinance. Seconded by Crow. Voice vote, all yes.

MINUTES: Prior meeting minutes were emailed to all for review. A motion to approve the minutes as presented for the April 20th, 2026 meeting, was made by Ridgeway and seconded by Strouse. Voice vote, all yes.

OLD BUSINESS: Vance was to check the existing Resolutions and Ordinances to verify if Hillcrest Drive had been changed from a 25 MPH zone and designated as a 15 MPH zone. Vance reported that he went as far back as the 2017 records and could not verify if a change was ever made to a 15 MPH zone. Hillcrest Drive is a designated 25 MPH zone. If speed limit is to be changed, will open to public input.

Looking at making the alley (Cherry Alley) at the Lyons Den a One-Way alley.

NEW BUSINESS: Resolution 2026-9 (Ladies Night Out event) and 2026-10 (Chicken Days event) was presented as a final reading. Motion to amend Resolution 2026-9 and 2026-10 Sections 1 by **deleting** [*The Village shall request insurance coverage of its insurer*] and **replace with:** [*Main Market & Beyond shall provide with Danville as co-insured insurance*] was made by Ridgeway and seconded by Crow. Voice vote, all yes. Motion to adopt amended Resolution 2026-9 and 2026-10 made by Furay and seconded by Crow. Voice vote, all yes.

Ordinance 2026-4 (Cybersecurity Program) was presented for a final reading. Each council member was given printouts explaining the program. Decision made to take the printouts home for review then possibly have final reading at next meeting.

Ordinance 2026-5 (amend 2026 appropriations – property insurance) was presented for emergency reading. Typo errors were noted to be corrected. Also, Section 2, **delete wording** [*appealed*] and **replace it with:** [*adopted*.] Crow made motion to amend, and Strouse seconded. Motion to suspend rules and have 3rd reading and adopt amended Ordinance 2026-5 made by Crow and seconded by Strouse. Voice vote, all yes.

Ordinance 2026-6 (amend 2026 appropriations – Admin staff's salary) was presented for emergency reading. Typo errors were noted to be corrected. Also, Section 2, **delete wording** [*appealed*] and **replace it with:** [*adopted*].

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NEW BUSINESS continued: Crow made motion to amend, and Strouse seconded. Motion to suspend rules and have 3rd reading and adopt amended Ordinance 2026-5 made by Crow and seconded by Strouse. Voice vote. All yes.

Ordinance 2026-7 to amend Ordinance 2026-3 by correcting the appropriations was presented for emergency reading. Crow made motion to suspend rules and have 3rd reading and Strouse seconded. Ridgeway made motion to adopt Ordinance 2026-7 and Meyers seconded. Voice vote, all yes.

LEGISLATION: Resolution 2026-9 *PASSED*. Resolution 2026-10 *PASSED*.

Ordinance 2026-4 *HOLD* until next meeting. Ordinance 2026-5 *PASSED*. Ordinance 2026-6 *PASSED*.

FINANCE: Furay made motion to pay bills and Durbin seconded. Voice vote, all yes.

Check into our DARE account at Killbuck Bank.

Sweeping account showing a minus balance every night but all checks are covered.

Sweeping account interest has increased from 3.05 % to 4%.

WATER/WASTEWATER: CDBG Community Grant (water line project) for Market St. goes out for bidding.

4 Hydrants were fixed.

Going to fix a sewer break on Progress Drive, 400 feet.

Getting a dumpster for sewer pond area cleaning.
