

RESOLUTION 2026-01

A resolution prohibiting the removal of financial records from the Administrative Building.

WHEREAS, the Village must keep track of all financial records; and

WHEREAS; there is a need for non-Danville employees to review these records.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby Resolved that:

The Village shall prohibit any removal of any original physical records from the Administrative Offices and Building. Further, there may be electronic copies made of records, but the original storage of said records shall remain on the premises.

However, if the records are kept in a cloud-based device, access may be permitted off-site, with permission of the Mayor, to access those records. Further, the Mayor may authorize some limited removal of original financial records and electronic records for a specific period of time.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the reasons stated above, said Resolution shall, therefore become effective upon its date of passage, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council of the Village of Danville, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
