

## Resolution No. 2026-2

### **Authorizing a Police Service Agreement Between the Village of Danville, Ohio and Butler Township, Located in Knox County, Ohio**

This Resolution is for the provision to authorize the Mayor and the Chief of Police of the Village of Danville, Ohio, to enter into an agreement of providing police services to Butler Township, hereafter referred to as “the Township” by the Village of Danville, hereafter referred to as “the Village”.

#### **Section 1.**

**WHEREAS**, The Township is empowered to acquire additional police protection for the residents, businesses, and property located within its territorial boundaries; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Village has an established police department, including access to dispatch and equipment to provide additional police protection to the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.43 authorizes the Township to contract for additional police protection within the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for good and valuable consideration, it is agreed that the contract between the Village and the Township is understood by Council as follows:

1. **Cost of Services:** Services shall be provided by the Village to the Township for the amount of \$500.00 compensation per month, payable within 30 days to the Village at the end of each quarter.
2. **Scope of Police Services:** Officer patrol time, subject to officer availability, will be 30 minutes per 8-hour shift, unless on an active call within the Township, will then complete call. The Chief of Police has sole authority and discretion in scheduling police services for the Township.
3. **Hold Harmless:** Chapter 2744 of the Ohio Revised Code, insofar as it is applicable to the operation of police departments, applies to the contracting political subdivision and police department members when the members are rendering service outside their own subdivision pursuant to the contract.

**Termination:** The Village and or the Township may terminate this agreement only upon providing the other party with 30 days’ notice prior to termination.

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### Section 2.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and said Resolution shall, therefore become effective on its date of passage, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council of the Village of Danville, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
