

Resolution No. 2026-3

Authorizing a Police Service Agreement Between the Village of Danville, Ohio and the Village of Brinkhaven, Located in Knox County, Ohio

This Resolution is for the provision to authorize the Mayor and the Chief of Police of the Village of Danville, Ohio, to enter into an agreement of providing police services to the Village of Brinkhaven, hereafter referred to as “Brinkhaven” by the Village of Danville, hereafter referred to as “the Village”.

Section 1.

WHEREAS, Brinkhaven is empowered to acquire additional police protection for the residents, businesses, and property located within its territorial boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, The Village has an established police department, including access to dispatch and equipment to provide additional police protection to Brinkhaven; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.43 authorizes Brinkhaven to contract for additional police protection within Brinkhaven.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, it is agreed that the contract between the Village and Brinkhaven is understood by Council as follows:

1. **Cost of Services:** Services shall be provided by the Village to Brinkhaven for the amount of \$125.00 compensation per month, payable within 30 days to the Village at the end of each quarter.
2. **Scope of Police Services:** Officer patrol time, subject to officer availability, will be 20 minutes per 8-hour shift, unless on an active call within Brinkhaven, will then complete call. The Chief of Police has sole authority and discretion in scheduling police services for Brinkhaven.
3. **Hold Harmless:** Chapter 2744 of the Ohio Revised Code, insofar as it is applicable to the operation of police departments, applies to the contracting political subdivision and police department members when the members are rendering service outside their own subdivision pursuant to the contract.

Termination: The Village and or the Township may terminate this agreement only upon providing the other party with 30 days’ notice prior to termination.

Section 2.

This Resolution will become effective after its third reading and date of passage, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to council of the Village of Danville, otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
